Introduction

Children at St Michael's wear school uniform because we wish them to be dressed the same. Where indicated please purchase items of uniform from our uniform supplier: <u>Lyndale Sports</u>. In cold weather, if your child wears a vest this should be plain white only.

<u>All</u> clothing, including underwear and footwear, <u>must be clearly marked.</u> Hair should be conventionally cut and suitable for school life. Boy's hair should be off the collar, eyebrows and ears

Uniform items should be purchased from our school uniform supplier at <u>Lyndale Sports</u>. Any item marked with and asterisk (*), can be sourced from any supplier, although Lyndale also stock most of these items.

Nursery Uniform and General Clothing Requirements



Children in the Nursery are expected to wear the following uniform:

- Nursery **plain** white polo shirt
- Nursery sweatshirt (logo)**
- Nursery **plain** black joggers
- Nursery black shorts for summer months (logo)**
- School tracksuit top (optional)**
- Trainers (any supplier and colour but correctly fitted)
- Socks can be children's own socks and children do not need to wear the school sports school in Nursery
- Slippers non-slip (any supplier to remain in school at all times) -optional
- Wellington boots (any supplier to remain in school at all times)
- Waterproof puddle suit for outside play (any supplier to remain in school at all times)

We would like your child to enjoy all the activities on offer in the Nursery, and despite aprons and dungarees being provided to protect clothing, inadvertently children may get wet/dirty and need to change their clothes. Therefore, please provide a **full change of spare clothes in a named bag. These do not need to be uniform but should be similar in style (black jogger bottoms and white t-shirts)** Please remember to include a number of changes of underwear and socks. Accidents can and do happen and if children have their own change of underwear it does make changing easier for them.

Swimming:

- School grey shorts (no turn-ups) (Years 3 to 6 only) OR
- School charcoal grey long trousers (no turn-ups) (Years 5 to Shell only)
- White (*long sleeved*) shirt* for special occasions

<u>Winter Terms</u> (Winter uniform may be worn until the end of **Lent Term** only.)

- Grey long or short sleeved shirt
- Plain dark grey ankle socks to be worn with long trousers (Years 5 to Shell only)
- School socks (long grey with pink stripe) worn with shorts (Years 3 to 6 only)
- Black shoes* (rubber-soled, not slip-on)

- ***School has in place an arrangement with a local dental technician to visit school in early September to measure and supply gum shields if you so wish. Information is sent to parents during the Trinity Term.



Girls Uniform List: Pre-Prep (Reception, Years 1 and 2)

Long hair that reaches below the child's shoulders should be tied back, either in a ponytail, half up-half down style, or similar. Hair accessories should be **plain and appropriately coloured** ie pink, white, grey or black.

Note: Hard 'Alice-bands' may not be worn for PE (due to risk of the 'teeth' pressing into the child's head). No jewellery may be worn at school except (one pair) of plain (eg. spherical) gold or silver studs (in the ear lobe only) if ears are pierced. **Make-up is not permitted.**

Girls Uniform List: Years 3 to Shell (inclusive)
